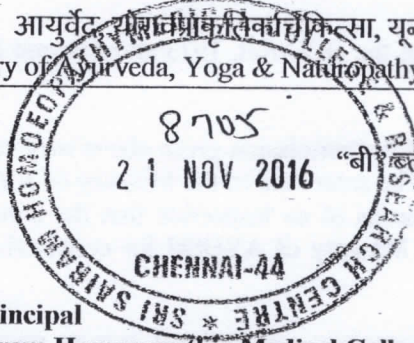

Sir,

I am directed to refer the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC (MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities by 31.12.2014 for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. Further, as per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC (MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fails to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in existing Courses.

2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, CCH has conducted the inspection of Sri Sairam Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Center, (Sapthagiri Education Trust), Sai Leo Nagar Tambaram West Chennai- 600044, on 03.05.2016 and furnished the recommendation of CCH for granting permission to take admissions during A.Y. 2016-17 in existing Courses, subject to removal of the following deficiencies:- “Reader not appointed in Anatomy, Physiology, Organon, Pharmacy, MM, FMT, Practice of Medicine Surgery, Obs. & Gynaecology Community Medicine and Repertory”.

3. After considering the provisions of HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the CCH, observations of Hearing Committee and policy of the Central Government for granting conditional permission during the session 2016-17, **permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Sri Sairam Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Center, (Sapthagiri Education Trust), Sai Leo Nagar Tambaram West Chennai- 600044, for continuing admissions in BHMS course with 50 seats for the academic session 2016-17 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2016 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2017-18:**

- i. The college shall obtain the NABH accreditation for the Hospital within one year and the NAAC accreditation for the College within two years from the issuance of the permission letter and the college shall submit its compliance to this Ministry as well as to the CCH within specified period;
- ii. All the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the “Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations 2013” by 31<sup>st</sup>

December 2016 to get permission for a period not exceeding five years. Failing which, all the existing colleges, which are not able to achieve full compliance of the requirement as specified in these regulations by the 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2016, shall be denied permission from academic year 2017-18 onwards and action as envisaged under section 19 of the Act shall be initiated against all such colleges apart from rejection of their applications under sections 12A, which have been under consideration by way of conditional permissions or denials"; and

iii. All the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

4. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the specified time period and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCH also. The CCH will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2017-18.

5. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by December, 2016 for continuing admissions during the subsequent years. CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2017-18 and furnish the recommendations to the Central Government.

In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has conducted inspection of Sri Sairam Homeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Sai Leo Nagar, West Tambaram, Chennai, on 16.05.2019 and furnished recommendation for allowing admission in I- BHMS Course for the session 2019-20 with the intake capacity of 50 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course.

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Sri Sairam Homeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Sai Leo Nagar, West Tambaram, Chennai for continuing admissions in I- BHMS course during the academic year 2019-20 with intake capacity of 50 seats.

3. It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate of the permitted intake capacity of 50 UG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats shall be conducted by the concerned State Government. If any seats are not filled up in the Central Counseling, the same shall be transferred to the concerned State Government to admit students as per their rules/ reservation policies/norms. The permission of the college will stand withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the Central counseling for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

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




4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.
5. The College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an affidavit duly notarized within one month from date of issue of this letter explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
6. Further, the College shall submit an undertaking in the form of an Affidavit duly notarized to get permanent registration of the Teachers./ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2019 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the documents submitted by the college authority for the admissions for the academic year 2020-21 in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 50 seats of Sri Sairam Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre, Sai Leo Nagar, West Tambaram, Chennai, Tamil Nadu-600044 and furnished recommendation vide its letter No. F. No. 15-8/2020-CCH (Visitation Matter) 3465 dated 2.11.2020 as under:-

"Recommended for allowing admission in 1-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of 50 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course.

The Committee also recommended to apprise the Ministry that college website is not updated and no Reader, either in full time or in guest faculty cadre available in 08 subjects (Anatomy, Organon, Pharmacy, FMT, POM, Surgery, CM & Repertory).

Further, the Committee also recommended to apprise the Ministry about ineligible teachers. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:

1. Dr M Jansi Rani, BHMS (Prof, OBG)- not considered eligible as Prof. as previous experience required for Prof. is not adequate as per MSE (joined on 7-02-07; no PG degree)
2. Dr Pratibha Vageeson (Prof, OBG)-on study leave."

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, conditional permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Sri Sairam Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre, Sai Leo Nagar, West Tambaram, Chennai, Tamil Nadu-600044, for continuing admissions in 1- BHMS course during the academic year 2020-21 with intake capacity of 50 seats subject to availability of Required number of Stretcher with trolley, Oxygen cylinder with stand & Diagnostic set (ENT), Animal Experiments demonstration with the help of Audio-visual Aids in dept. of Physiology, Required number of Software in Dept of Repertory and to fulfil all deficiencies as reflected at para 1 within 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020 from date of issue of this letter.

3. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counselling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government vide letter F. No. L. 11011/02/2020-E-(1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.
5. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
6. Further, the College shall comply the procedure to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.
7. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2021-22 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
