ORDER:

1. In his letter first read above, the Secretary of Sapthagiri Educational Trust, Chennai has requested to grant permission to the Trust to start a self-financing Homoeopathy Medical College and Research Centre at Poonthandalam, Sriperumbudur Taluk, Kancheepuram District.

2. In the letter second read above, the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Homoeopathy Medical Council has stated that a Committee headed by Dr. S. Koppikar (Chairman), President of the Council has inspected the site of the proposed College and submitted a report. The Tamil Nadu Homoeopathy Council considered the inspection report on the proposed "Sri Sairam Homoeopathy Medical College and Research Centre", Poonthandalam Village, Sriperumbudur Taluk, in detail and has stated that Sapthagiri Educational Trust and its members of the Board of Trustees are financially viable and hope that the Trust would run the College efficiently as per the Central Council of Homoeopathy norms. The Tamil Nadu Homoeopathy Medical Council has recommended to the Government to accord permission to start I BHMS Course by Sapthagiri Educational Trust.

3. The Government, after careful examination have decided to accept the recommendation of the Tamil Nadu Homoeopathy Medical Council. Accordingly, the Government permit "Sri Sapthagiri Educational Trust" to start a self-financing Homoeopathy Medical College in the name of "Sri Sairam Homoeopathy Medical College and Research Centre" at Poonthandalam, Sriperumbudur Taluk, Kancheepuram District, subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions, failing which the permission granted is liable for cancellation:-

P.T.O.

- i) The trust should make arrangements to construct additional building and provide necessary infrastructural facilities at Poonthandalam, Sriperumbudur Taluk, Kanchipuram District within a year.
- ii) The Trust should fulfil the minimum standards prescribed by the Central Council of Homoeopathy.
- iii) The trust should fulfil the norms of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University for affiliation with the University.
- iv) The selection and admission procedure of Government, as per the schemes of admission enunciated by the judgement of the Supreme Court of India should be followed strictly.
- v) There will be no financial aid from the Government at any time and
- vi) The admission strength should not exceed 50 students (Fifty) per year.
